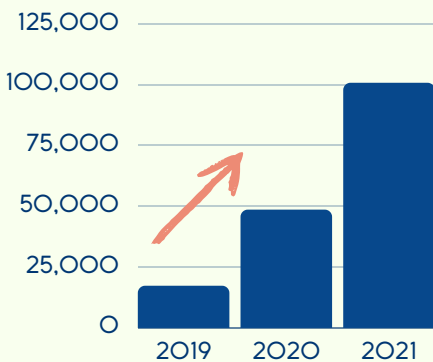

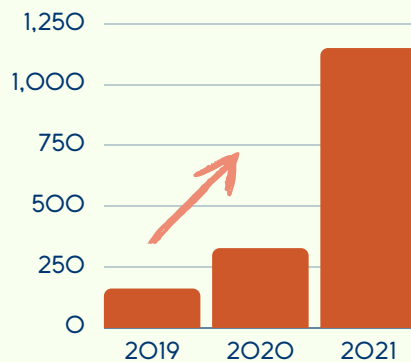

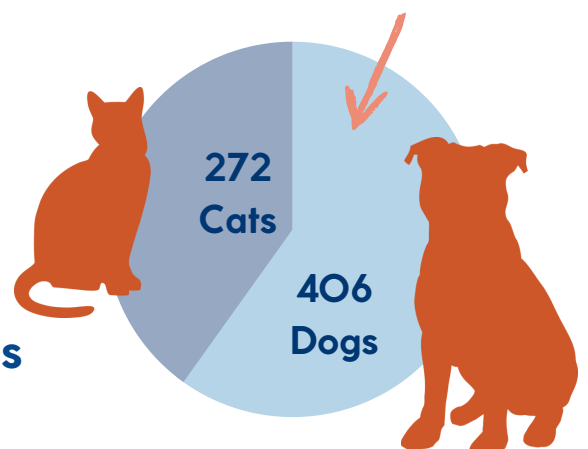

Foster Program

401 animals were cared for through **180 foster homes**. Our foster program reduced length of stay for animals in our shelter and provided vital support for newborn animals and those needing more time prior to adoption due to medical treatment or behavioral support.

Administered **724 vaccines** and **188 microchips** through our spay/neuter clinic.

Providing life-saving vet care for animals prior to adoption.

Nearly every animal in our care in 2021 needed more than just routine veterinary exams and vaccines.

More than **60 animals** required urgent or specialized veterinary care, ranging from surgical procedures to diagnostic testing and long-term treatment.

22 animals had to be treated at an emergency clinic for longer than one day.
